

Tue July 7	TL 786 967Didlington ParkPark beside the house and cart shednext to Home Farm house.Access thePark along a track which leads from thepublic highway to the east, at TL 794966.Fen and mire and also arablehabitats.		
Sat Jul 11	TG 250 286Bryant's HeathRubus workshop with Alec Bull.Meet at the Felmingham Weavers Waycar park.(15)		
Thur July 16	TG 346 272 East Ruston and Honing Meet at the East Ruston Weavers Way car park. (16)		
Thur July 23	TG 106 080Wramplingham areaMeet at Barford church car park (at the far end of the churchyard down an unmade track).(17)

Tue Aug 25	TL 546 944Welney WashesPark at Welney Wetland Centre. An opportunity to survey different parts of the Reserve, some of which are private.(23)		
Wed Sep 2	TF 974 169 Gressenhall <i>Rosa</i> workshop in the study room at Gressenhall Workhouse. Please feel free to bring wild rose specimens (an inflorescence with hips and a section of mature leading stem with a number of leaves) together with notes on size and habit of the plant and the habitat. (24)
